## Project Summary:

### Challenges Faced:

- Ben Line Project Logistics approached its vendors and worked through the night to find a suitable aircraft to carry the critical cargo within a time limit that far exceeded the client expectations.
- Finding an aircraft that could self-load and discharge due to the weight of the cargo and limited ground handling equipment at both airports.
- Obtaining permits from the civil aviation authority in a shorter than normal time frame.
